Akshaya Tritiya 2026:

Turning tradition into potential opportunity with smart investments in Gold and Silver!



Akshaya Tritiya symbolises prosperity that is known to grow endlessly. For generations, Indians have marked this auspicious day by buying gold and silver in the form of jewellery, coins, bars, etc., believing that it brings enduring wealth. However, in today's dynamic financial landscape, the way in which we invest in these precious metals is evolving. One can opt for investing via the Mutual Fund (MF) route - that is via Exchange Traded Funds (ETFs) and Fund of Funds (FoFs).

Investors can gain exposure to Gold by investing in **HDFC Gold ETF** and/or **HDFC Gold ETF Fund of Fund**. Similarly, they can gain exposure to silver by investing in **HDFC Silver ETF** and/or **HDFC Silver ETF Fund of Fund**. HDFC Gold ETF invests in physical gold with 99.5% fineness or above~ and HDFC Silver ETF invests in physical silver with 99.9% fineness or above~. HDFC Gold ETF Fund of Fund and HDFC Silver ETF Fund of Fund invests in the units of HDFC Gold ETF and HDFC Silver ETF respectively. FoF investors also enjoy these benefits as the FoF invests in the respective ETF units. Thus, investors are saved from the hassle of physical storage as the respective ETF scheme stores the respective metal with the custodian in secure vaults.

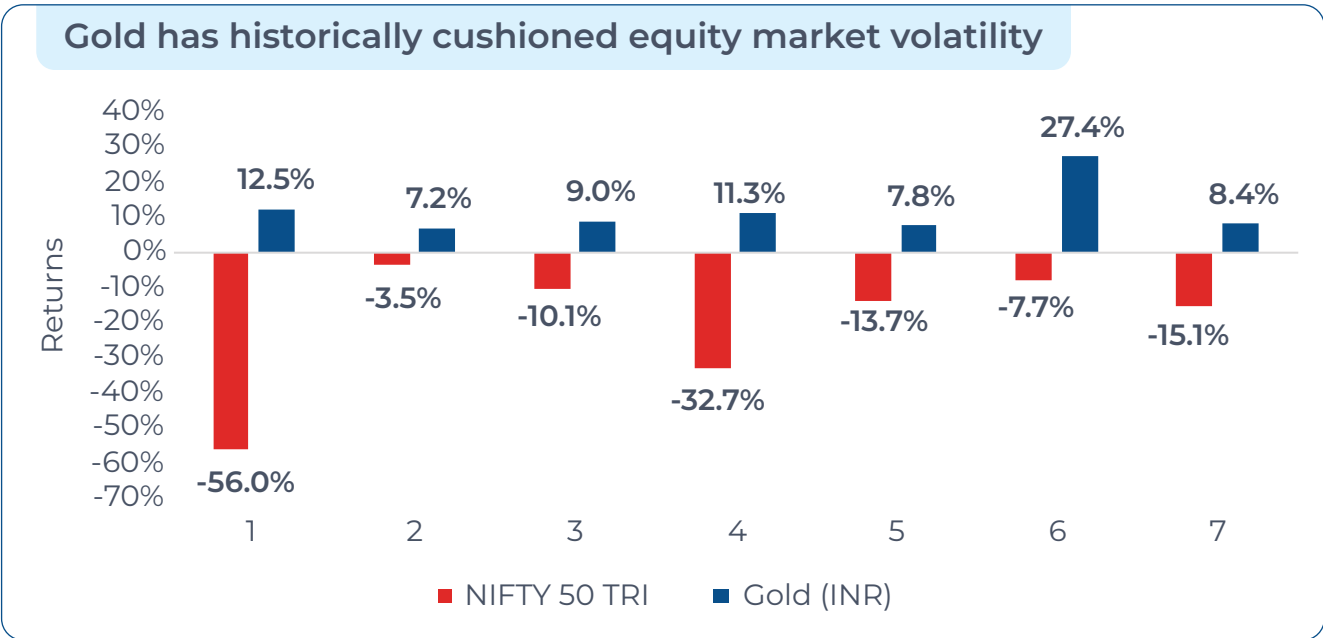

Recent price correction: A window of opportunity?


This year, the festival arrives at an interesting juncture - against the backdrop of geopolitical tensions and a recent correction in gold and silver prices. This makes it not just symbolic, but potentially opportune.

Gold’s long-term outlook remains supportive. Many large economies are facing weakening fiscal positions with trade disputes and geopolitical tensions resulting in a more fragmented global world. In such an environment, gold can continue to play an important role as a hedge against uncertainty.

Silver prices are heavily influenced by industrial demand because the metal is widely used in new age and green technologies such as solar panels and electric vehicles. Since this demand depends on economic activity, any slowdown can impact prices. Global conflicts disrupted industrial production, which reduced demand for silver and led to a sharp correction in its price.



However, the long-term outlook for silver remains supportive. Demand for the metal continues to grow due to its increasing use in electric vehicles, solar energy, 5G infrastructure and AI-related electronics. In addition, investors often buy silver, which adds to investment demand.

On the supply side, silver faced a supply shortage for the fifth year in a row (Source: The Silver Institute – World Silver Survey 2026), meaning demand is likely to remain higher than supply. This structural deficit could help support prices over time.

A smart and modern way to get exposure to Gold & Silver!

One can invest through the MF route in Gold and Silver via ETFs and FoFs. ETFs can be traded on a Stock Exchange and require a demat account. FoFs invest in units of the ETF and a demat account is not required to invest in FoFs.

Investing in these instruments offers the following:



Convenience & Safety: Investors are saved from the hassle of physical storage themselves. HDFC Gold ETF invests in physical gold and HDFC Gold ETF FoF invests in HDFC Gold ETF units. HDFC Silver ETF invests in physical silver and HDFC Silver ETF FoF invests in HDFC Silver ETF units.



Purity: HDFC Gold ETF invests in physical gold with 99.5% fineness or above[@] and HDFC Silver ETF invests in physical silver with 99.9% fineness or above[#]



Liquidity: For the ETFs, Market Makers provide liquidity on the Stock Exchange. For the FoFs, investors can invest or redeem units on a daily basis



Invest regularly with small amounts: Investors can set up SIPs into the ETFs as most brokers allow this feature. For the FoFs - SIP, STP and SWP
